Business Services

Controller's Office

The Controller's Office is committed to providing the highest quality business, accounting, tax, and financial reporting that fosters integrity and accountability while maximizing efficiency, accuracy, and productivity. This is accomplished by giving guidance in accounting, financial reporting, tax compliance, and grant financial administration.

Facilities Management

Facilities Management represents five core areas of expertise and service, including three operational areas. With approximately 500 employees dedicated to excellence, Facilities Management serves the university through a range of functions, including building care and landscaping, facilities information services, construction and project management, and utilities.

Public Safety

The Department of Public Safety provides each member of the UI community with a sense of security throughout campus by creating a safe learning environment at all times and educating students, faculty, and staff in matters of protection and personal responsibility.

Treasury Operations and Financial Management

Treasury Operations has the overall responsibility of administering and overseeing university banking, cash management, and investment services. Treasury Operations houses ID Card Programs and the University Billing Office.
